IdapCreateUsers	Allow creation of new users	Create users logging in, that cannot be found inside the LDAP. User must belong to IdapDomainDefault	<u>Integration/LDAP</u>

IdapMaintainGroupsOnLogon	Maintain groups on logon	LDAP validation also synchronizes groups found for logged in user.	<u>Integration/LDAP</u>
